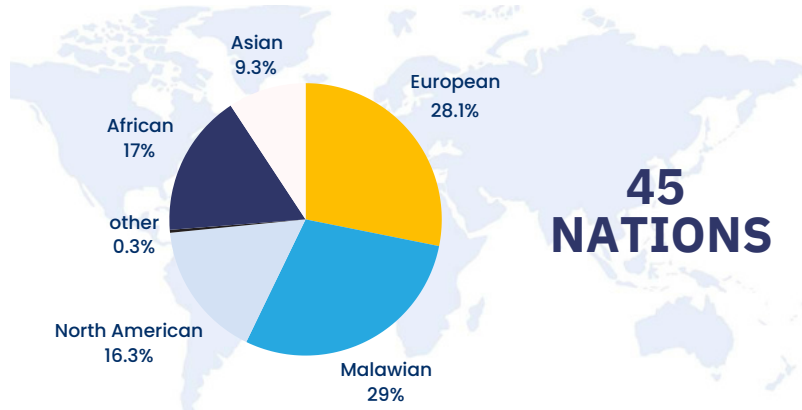
We are a diverse and welcoming community in a joyful learning environment that promotes well-being, sustainability, and inclusivity and celebrates growth as success.

BMIS is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) and by the Council of International Schools (CIS), and is authorized by the IBO for the PYP, MYP, and DP, and by Pearson for our Extended Project Qualification.

Academic Programs

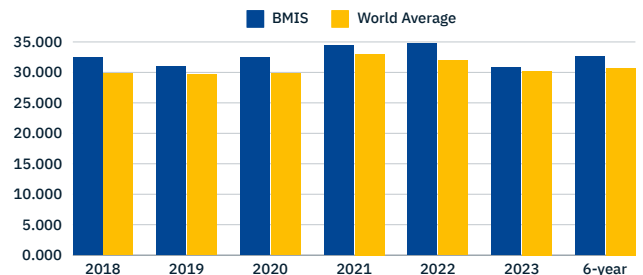
BMIS has three college-prep pathways, all of which include a BMIS High School Diploma (HSD) accredited by NEASC. The majority of our students study the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (DP), while a smaller number take the IB Diploma Courses Programme (DCP).

Within these programmes, students choose a selection of courses and core components that best suit their strengths and aspirations. What we want is for students' experiences in the DP or DCP to be healthy and positive while maximizing academic achievement.

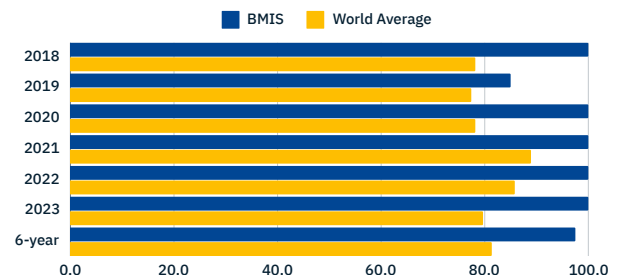
To this end, finding the best fit for each student is crucial. Students not taking the DP or DCP pathway are in the High School Diploma Program, and they choose at least five HSD or IBDP courses, one of which may be the Career Skills Course, and all are expected to complete the Extended Program Qualification (certified by Pearson).

Graduation Requirements

The BMIS HSD is a four-year pre-university qualification for all students in Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12. Students gain 1 credit by achieving a 3-7 on their end-of-year report or 1.5 credits for 3-7 in IB DP HL subjects only. Graduation requirements:

- 12 credits by the end of Grade 10
- 22 credits by the end of Grade 12
- Completion of the MYP Service as Action Programme in Grade 10 and CAS in Grade 12

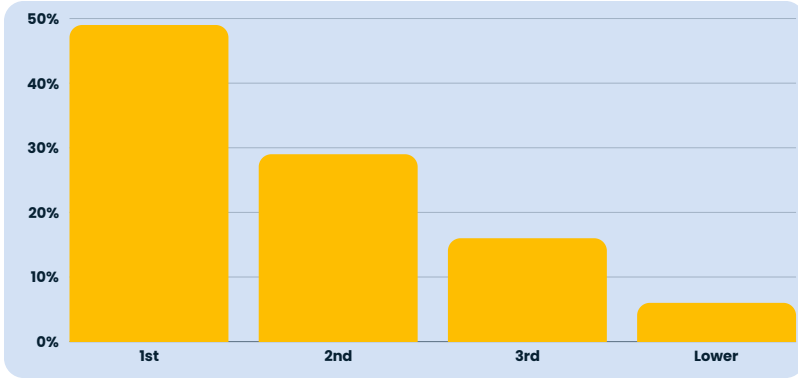

University Acceptances

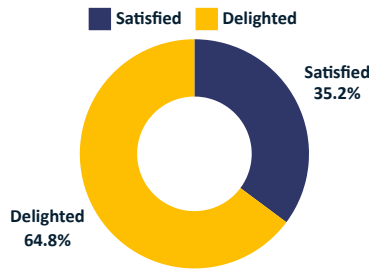


1st - 3rd Choice Universities Acceptances



Student Satisfaction

Over the last three years, 49% of BMIS graduates have been accepted into their first choice university course, with 94% being accepted into at least one of their top three choices. When all BMIS graduates were asked how they felt about the universities and courses they were accepted in (either delighted, satisfied or disappointed), precisely 0% were disappointed. When asked where the course they chose to attend ranked in the world, 88% of students confirmed it was in the top 100 in its field.
